United Nashelsker Societies Prepare For Israel Parley

The United Nashelsker National Presidium announced that the 1968 convention of the United Nashelsker Societies of America will be held in Israel on April 27 to April 30, with 150 delegates from the United States, Europe, South America and Mexico.

JOSEPH KORN, local president, will head a delegation of 52 representing the West Coast. They will leave from here on a special Nashelsker Israel tour on April 21.

This convention originally scheduled to take place in Los Angeles, was changed to Israel to give the constituents the opportunity to visit Israel and to see the housing project and public institutions erected there by Nashelsker Societies of America. They will participate in the celebration of Israel's 20th anniversary.

THE NASHELSKER Societies for the past 20 years have devoted their energies on behalf of Israel. They have established a housing colony in Kiryat Ono known as Nachlat Nashelsk of 100 homes, several public buildings, a community center, a synagogue, a children's nursery and a public library.

Nashelsker Convention In Israel

Forty-three West Coast delegates, (37 from Los Angeles) will leave Apr. 21 to attend the Nashelsker convention in Israel. Joseph Korn, local president, will head the delegation.

The convention will open with a banquet in Tel Aviv on Apr. 27. Business sessions will be held in Kiryat Ono, where the Nashelsker Societies of America have erected 100 homes. Benjamin M. Bendat, past national president, will be convention chairman.

One hundred scholarships for higher education will be distributed to Israeli students during this convention. Continuation of scholarships, increasing the Free Loan Fund, and the publishing of a Nashelsker Memorial Book will be considered. Officers to serve for the next three years will be elected.

MAYOR KOHN OF KIRYAT ONO ON VISIT IN L.A.

Honorable Yacob Kohn, Mayor of Kiryat Ono, Israel, will be honored and will speak at two meetings Saturday and Sunday, climaxing his week-long visit to Los Angeles.

He will address a meeting of the Shelters for Israel organization, 8 p.m. tomorrow, Saturday, June 24, at the home of Adolphe Markowitz, president, and will be honored at a 6:30 p.m. reception, Sunday, June 25, sponsored by the Nashelsker Relief Society at Beth Israel Congregation, 8056 Beverly Blvd.

MAYOR KOHN, who participated in the recent International Mayors Congress in Washington, D. C., addressed a joint meeting of the Carmel and Los Angeles chapters of Bnai Zion last Thursday and was received in the City Council chambers by Council president John S. Gibson. Speakers at the Bnai Zion session were Fred Kahan, president of the Los Angeles Bnai Zion Council; Rabbi Chaim J. Weinstein, spiritual leader of Hollywood Temple Beth El, and Louis J. Volk, Carmel chapter president.

Other highlights of the Israeli official's visit included luncheon meetings, sponsored by the California-Israel Chamber of Commerce and Rassco Associates of Los Angeles.

Benj. Bendat First Angeleno to Be Honorary Mayor of Israeli Town

Benjamin M. Bendat of Los Angeles lays claim to a unique honor. He is believed to be the only American who is honorary mayor of an Israeli town. Mayor Yakob Kohn of Kiryat Ono, Israel, who recently spent a week in Los Angeles conferring with Jewish National Fund leaders, conferred this honor upon Bendat at ceremonies in Los Angeles City Hall. These were attended by John S. Gibson, former president of the L. A. City Council, and Fred Kahan, JNF west coast director.

Mr. Bendat, as national president of the United Nashelsker Relief Societies of America, was instrumental in establishing a housing project in Kiryat Ono. The Nashelsker housing project is on land made available by the Jewish National Fund.

Bendat who has long been active in Jewish community affairs, was recently elected western states regional president of the American Congress of Polish Jews, a body uniting some 29 groups to effectuate reparations and to establish a fitting memorial for the vanished Polish Jewry.

My sincerest personal gratitude for your devoted cooperation, and for the privilege of serving you in the pursuit of our goals.

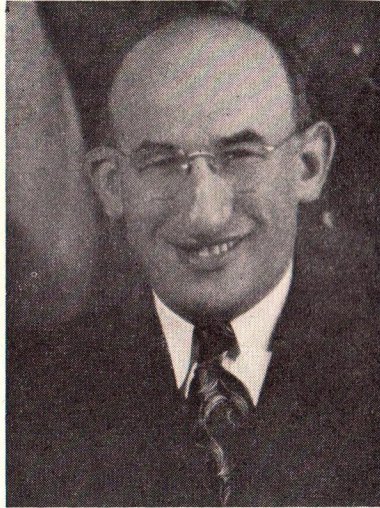

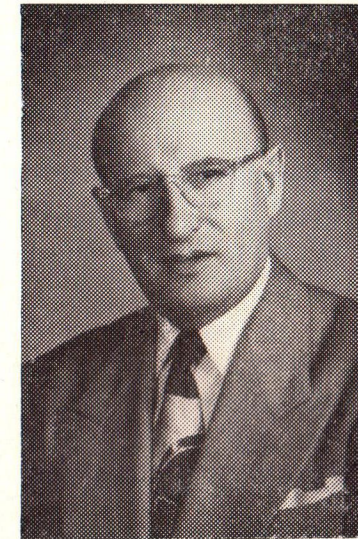
Again as heretofore, we will partake in all of the endeavors of the Jewish Community in Los Angeles and contribute our share in all the worthwhile projects.

“OUR ISRAEL SCHOLARSHIP FUND”

The details of the \$25,000.00 Scholarship Fund, adopted at the 1963 Los Angeles Convention, was presented to the Israel Committee during a visit of a delegation from Los Angeles.

Upon their return to Los Angeles, the delegation headed by our President, Mrs. Milton M. Glatt, presented to the membership the results of the deliberation with the Israel Committee. Their enthusiasm and glowing reports of the reaction in Israel inspired the entire membership. Within ninety days the first \$5,000.00 was raised and forwarded to Israel.

One only has to read the glowing remarks expressed by the participants at our housing colony in Kiryat Ono, Israel, on the historic evening of April 29th, 1964, marking the first distribution of 52 scholarships to Israeli students, to fully comprehend the importance of this project.

Our membership fully realizes the value of this scholarship fund. We are aware that by giving Israel's youth an opportunity for secondary and higher education, we also ensure the security and future of Israel. We, the Nashelsker members of Los Angeles are determined to raise the full amount of \$25,000.00 as speedily as possible. By the end of 1964 another \$5,000.00 was ready to be sent to Israel. Thus, the sum of \$10,000.00 was raised and contributed during the first year.

Our entire membership is to be congratulated for their devotion and dedication, for their untiring work in the past twenty years on behalf of Israel. As the year comes to a close we are determined to continue this scholarship fund, as long as the need exists in Israel.

It is my fervent hope and prayer that the next decade of the membership of the Los Angeles Nashelsker Society will continue in the tradition of service to our fellow man.

HIGHLIGHTS OF CEREMONY MARKING PRESENTATION OF 52 SCHOLARSHIPS AT KIRYAT-ONO, ISRAEL, APRIL 29th, 1964

REMARKS BY MAYOR KOHN:

REMARKS BY ISRAEL YAGODA, Chairman of the Scholarship Fund in Israel:

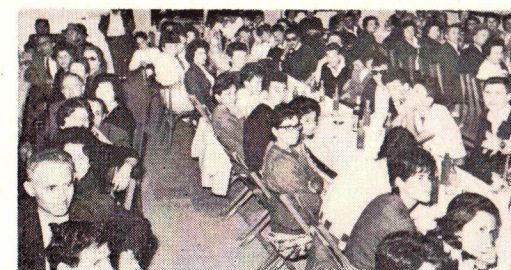
